All are posted on rotation basis every month.

#### **ACTIVITIES AT THE CENTRE:**

- Out patient services week days from 10.00am to 1.00pm.
- **Specialist services:**
- Gynecology: Every Tuesdays from 6.00pm to 8.00pm.
- Ophthalmology: Every Thursdays from 10.00am to 1pm.
- Physiotherapy: 5 days in a week from 10.00am to 1.00pm.
- Annual School health checkup programme for all the 36 schools coming under the mid day meal of Sri Sai Mandali.
- Health education programme on HIV/Aids for high school students.
- Annual general and geriatric health camp from 2007.

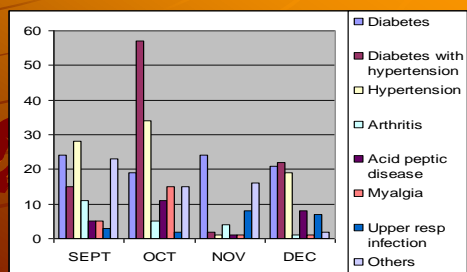
## HEALTH DATA:

- 360 to 670 monthly out patient cases with 40.6% males and 59.4% women.
