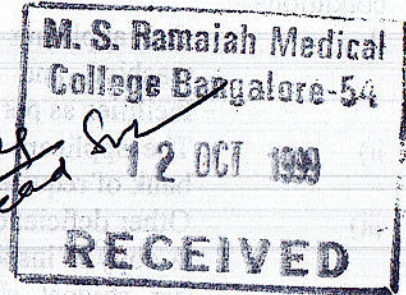


3. This letter of intent is subject ^{to} ~~of~~ the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- i) The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipments and hospital facilities as per the medical Council of India norms
- ii) The applicant should provide a bank guarantee of a national/scheduled bank of required sum as per Council's norms.
- iii) Other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report should be rectified. A copy of inspection report is enclosed.
- iv) No student should be admitted to the above course till the formal permission of the Central Government is granted.

4. Action to grant formal permission of the Central Government for starting of the said PG degree/diploma course(s) at the college/Institute will be initiated on receipt of a compliance letter fulfilling the conditions enumerated in para 3 above.
