Fastidious and non-cultivable micro-organisms pose an additional challenge to current culture methods. Although strategies that include serological tests for diagnosis have been included in the past, the need for additional testing has always been felt.</p> <p>Molecular methods based on Nucleic acid amplification techniques (NAATs) have gained great importance in the diagnosis of infectious diseases. Molecular methods have improved both pathogen positivity rates and turnaround times (TAT) as compared to routine culture methods. Hence this workshop is being conducted with the aim to provide an insight into the current available molecular diagnostic methods in Clinical Microbiology.</p> <p>Gastrointestinal infections are commonly encountered in community and hospital settings. Most of these infections may not be severe and often resolve rapidly.
