he Book 'Approach to Clinical Endocrinology through selected case studies' edited by Dr. Chandra Mohan Batra and Dr. Pramila Kalra is a scientific case study-based approach to endocrinology. Dr. Chandra Mohan a senior consultant endocrinologist at Apollo Hospitals, New Delhi, and Dr. Pramila Kalra, Professor, and Head of the Department of Endocrinology at MS Ramaiah Medical College and Hospitals in Bengaluru have edited this important volume which includes 21 clinical cases of endocrinology and their complexities explained in a simple manner.

Endocrinology is a field in biology and medicine that deals with the endocrine system. The organs involved in the endocrine system include the pituitary, thyroid, adrenals, ovaries, testes, and pancreas. Endocrinology involves diagnosing and treating diseases of this system.

According to Dr. Pramila Kalra the book deals with authentic information on the subject as the authors approached the subject through case studies that focused on clinical medicine. Likewise, this book consists of 21 selected cases of Endocrinology which are well-written and complex cases that are finely discussed. Qualified and well-experienced endocrinologists across India, both from academic and research centers, have contributed their studies to this book.


Dr. Pramila Kalra has said that this book will be useful for endocrinology students, undergraduates, postgraduates, and post-doctoral researchers. Topics like Pituitary, thyroid, reproductive Endocrinology, bones, parathyroid, diabetes mellitus, and adrenal disorders are covered in this book.

In its approach, the book a case compendium provides an overview of clinical endocrinology and how to address an

endocrine case, including investigation, management, and follow-up. Each case is different, and each one will tell a story that will assist a clinical endocrinologist in managing a situation.

This will be a referral book for those who are interested in Endocrinology. It will help physicians, interns, and students of UG and PG as a quide and a reference book.

The stepwise approach of the book covers history,



examination of findings, clinical diagnosis, investigation, confirmation of the diagnosis, and treatment. Each case, in the end, has a message in a form of a conclusion, which will help a clinician to manage endocrine cases.


