Subject: Renewal of Undergraduate Seats (MBBS) of MS Ramaiah Medical College Bangalore, for the year AY- 2025-26 - regarding.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Public Notice issued by UGMEB vide dated 01.11.2024 uploaded on the NMC website on 06.11.2024, directing all medical colleges with valid Letters of Permission (LoP) to upload the details/data of their respective institutions on the NMC portal for the annual declaration, as required under the NMC Act, 2019 and various regulations issued by NMC from time to time, for the grant of renewal of MBBS seats for the academic year 2025-26.

2. Based on the details furnished by your college, the experts assessed the submissions, and accordingly, a Notice dated **16.05.2025** was issued highlighting the following deficiencies observed during the assessment:

- i. Seven (07) out of Nineteen (19) departments are deficient in faculty/Resident/tutor as per AEBAS record data.

3. Subsequently, the compliance report submitted by your Institution was also evaluated by the Assessors; however, amongst other deficiencies, following key deficiencies were again highlighted w.r.t. your College/Institution:

- i. Departments are deficient in faculty/Resident/tutor as per AEBAS record data, however your explanation has been accepted therefore, the college may adhere to the deficiencies found in the AEBAS

Further, it has been observed that during the renewal process for the previous year AY 2024-25, Penalty was imposed and conditional renewal was granted in view of the substantive nature of deficiencies in your College.

4. The Competent Authority has reviewed the Annual Declaration Report (ADR) submitted by your college/institutions and also the deficiencies pointed out by the experts. The compliance report submitted by the college has not been found to be convincing and satisfactory.

5. However, UGMEB has taken a lenient view and **decided to grant conditional renewal of 150 UG (MBBS) seats** for the academic year 2025-26, **subject to rectification of deficiencies within four months from the issuance of this letter.**

6. A further review will be conducted after four months, and if the deficiencies are found to persist at that time, stringent action will be initiated as mandated under Chapter III, Clause 8 of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations (MSMER), 2023, and any other applicable rules or regulations.

7. If the College/Institution is not satisfied and aggrieved with the decision of the Board, you may prefer an appeal before the Commission under Section 9, Chapter IV of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023, (MSMER, 2023) within Sixty (60) days of the issue of this letter.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your application for grant of Continuation of Recognition of MBBS degree (150 seats) awarded by M.S. Ramaiah University of Applied Sciences, Bangalore in respect of the students being trained at M. S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore u/s 11(2) of IMC Act, 1956 and Section 35(4) of the NMC Act, 2019 during the year 2022-23 and to say that your college was assessed by the Assessors appointed by MARB to conduct virtual assessment during the final MBBS practical Examination from 18th to 21st August, 2022. The report of physical assessment is not available with UGMEB. However, as per the decision taken in the Commission in its meeting held on 11.04.2023, in case infrastructural assessment as well as examination assessment have been carried out, the application for Continuation of Recognition should be processed as per the regulation norms. In case only one assessment has been carried out, Continuation of Recognition is to be processed for only one year henceforth.

2. Accordingly, your application for grant of Continuation of Recognition (for one year only) of MBBS degree 150 seats, awarded by M.S. Ramaiah University of Applied Sciences, Bangalore in respect of the students being trained at M. S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore has been considered in Under Graduate Medical Education Board (UGMEB) alongwith the data available on AEBAS and HMIS including CCTV.

3. After careful consideration of the report and AEBAS records, it has been decided in Under Graduate Medical Education Board (UGMEB) that Recognition may be granted to the MBBS degree awarded by M.S. Ramaiah University of Applied Sciences, Bangalore to 150 students of M. S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore. However, department of physical Medicine and Rehabilitation (PMR) also needs to be established.

4. Accordingly, the approval of the competent authority is hereby conveyed for grant of **CONTINUATION OF RECOGNITION FOR ONE YEAR** of MBBS degree for 150 students, granted by M.S. Ramaiah University of Applied Sciences, Bangalore in respect of the students being trained at M. S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore.

5. However, the college authorities are advised to apply afresh to Under Graduate Medical Education Board (UGMEB) in the year 2024 for Continuation of Recognition, at least six (6) months prior to the final examination of MBBS Part-II (Practical) alongwith the requisite fee i.e. of Rs.3.54 lakhs only. Further consideration of Continuation of Recognition is subject to availability of both the Assessment Reports (Virtual Assessment during the final practical examination to evaluate the standard of examination and physical Assessment Report to verify the facilities available at your medical colleges including the faculties and clinical materials etc.) and authentication of records on AEBAS, HMIS and CCTV footage, etc.

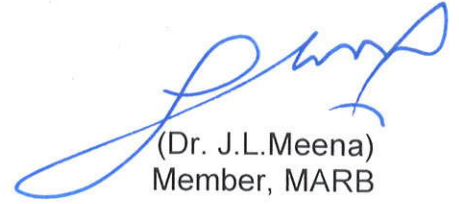

Sub. Consideration of Compliance Verification Assessment with regard to continuance of recognition of MBBS degree granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at M.S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore.

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to inform that the compliance verification assessment of the physical and the other teaching facilities available for continuance of recognition of MBBS degree granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at M.S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore was carried out by the Council Assessors on 29th April, 2016. The compliance verification assessment report (29th April, 2016) along with the previous assessment reports (3.2.2016 & 26th Aug, 2014) was considered by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 13.05.2016. The following recommendations of the Executive Committee was approved by the General Body of the Council at its meeting held on 22nd November, 2016:-

"The Executive Committee of the Council considered the compliance verification assessment report (29th April, 2016) along with the previous assessment reports (3.2.2016 & 26th Aug, 2014) and decided to recommend that recognition of MBBS degree granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at M.S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore be continued restricting the number of admission to 150 (One Hundred fifty) students.

The Executive Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations (Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16th April 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

8 (3) ...

(2) The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.

(3) The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.

(4) Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute."

The above decision of the General Body has been approved by the Oversight Committee on 28.04.2017.
