It will be a comprehensive cancer care centre with facilities for screening, diagnosis, therapy and supportive care. There are dedicated areas earmarked for each

In its move towards excellence, the hospital is in the process of co-branding and instituting clinical protocols with a major US-based multi-superspecialty medical institution. There are planned exchanges of faculty, nursing and quality managers from both hospitals.

Ramaiah Institute of Oncology (RIO) is equipped with state-of-the-art diagnostics including advanced laboratory tests for oncology and radiology imaging. Ramaiah Memorial Hospital has a three-Tesla MRI, a cutting-edge tech empowered mammogram and nuclear medicine facilities that include PET scan.

The radiation oncology team has a highly experienced faculty supported by state of the art cutting-edge medical technologies such as LINAC (linear accelerator) equipment to deliver radiotherapy (radiation therapy). The radiation oncology sub-specialty is recognised as a centre of excellence, in itself, for brachytherapy - a type of radiotherapy.

The medical oncology team is driven by organ-wise specialists who provide proto-col-based clinical services to cancer patients for solid tumours as well as for blood cancers, both in adults and children. The highly experienced faculty is supported by trained clinical pharmacists and oncology nurses.

The centre has a robust bone marrow transplant sub-unit which is supported by a very highly advanced, state-of-the-art blood bank and stem cell lab.

The surgical oncology team caters to all varieties of cancers requiring surgery. The team performs open, laparoscopic and robotic cancer surgeries. Emphasis is on quality of care and outcomes.

RIO is equipped with an advanced cancer detection mobile van and is in the process of adding a palliative care mobile van to meet patient requirements at their doorstep. RIO is also facilitating psychological support mechanisms for both patients and caregivers along with initiating patient support groups for common cancers.

These initiatives will go a long way in meeting all the needs of cancer-affected people. They will further augment survivor population as RIO strives to beat cancer.

Intra-operative radiotherapy (IORT) -WOMED 50, (first of its kind in Asia and second in the world)First patient was treated using IORT at Ramaiah memorial hospital, Bengaluru on 24th April 2024. As the name suggests, the special and unique feature of this IORT technique is that it involves precise delivery of large doses of ionising radiation to the tumor/tumor bed while the tumor site is exposed during surgery. By directly visualising the tumor bed, we will be able to precisely deliver the treatment allowing maximum dose to the tumor as well as minimising the dose to the surrounding normal healthy tissues by displacing them as well as shielding. Also IORT has opportunities for dose escalation beyond EBRT dose and re-irradiation in recurrent cancers where EBRT may not be possible. Another advantage is that since it is a low energy X-ray (50kV), the exposure to the staff is almost nil and do not require special shielding. Recently it has emerged as an attractive treatment option for early breast cancer as well as selected locally advanced breast cancer, the main advantage being the ability to complete the entire course of radiation in a single sitting during surgery itself. The waiting period following surgery to enable post -op recovery and the surgical scar to heal as well as the prolonged external beam radiation treatment of 4-6 weeks following surgery are avoided forming added benefits of IORT. In the same sitting during surgery, the radiation treatment is completed. Sometimes it is also combined along with EBRT based on the stage and diagnosis. It is used in a wide variety of sites such as breast cancer, locally advanced and recurrent rectal cancer, retroperitoneal sarcomas, soft tissue sarcomas, pancreatic cancer, gynecologic and genito-urinary and recurrent malignancies.

Many young radiation oncologist fears to incorporate brachytherapy procedures in their practices. The story of Mr. Jyotish, a resident from our field practice area, exemplifies the impact of timely medical intervention and multidisciplinary teamwork.

When a diabetes-related complication, initially mismanaged elsewhere, threatened his health, swift action was taken by our Medical Social Workers, Mr. Ravikumar (RICPHI) and Mr. Harish (Community Medicine), who promptly referred him to our hospital under the guidance of Dr. Ananth Ram.

Upon arrival, Mr. Jyotish required an emergency fasciotomy, expertly performed by Dr. Bharati and Dr. Suhas from the Department of Surgery. Shortly after, he faced a life-threatening health challenge that rapidly escalated, with severe end-organ damage affecting the kidneys, liver, and lungs, compounded by dengue-related thrombocytopenia.

Despite these challenges, coordinated efforts by our ICU team, the Infectious Diseases unit led by Dr. Srikanth and Dr. Sandeep Reddy, residents from the Department of General Medicine, and our dedicated nursing staff ensured comprehensive care and expert management during the critical period.

Today, Mr. Jyotish is on a steady path to recovery. With ongoing follow-ups facilitated by our Medical Social Workers and diligent care by interns who manage his periodic wound dressings at Kaiwara PHC, he is healing well at home.

This case highlights the essence of patient-centred care and the seamless collaboration between our departments. We take pride in these efforts and wish Mr. Jyotish a complete and swift recovery.
