 Dr. Rama Bhat is currently Professor Emerita in the Department of Pediatrics at University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC). Dr. Bhat is a graduate of Mysore Medical College and did his post graduate training in Pediatrics at KEM Hospital in Mumbai (CCH) and at John Hopkins affiliated Hospital in Baltimore and his Neonatology fellowship at University of Illinois at Chicago.  
 He has over 70 publications in peer reviewed journals. Dr. Bhat has been recognized as an outstanding teacher by the residents, fellows and nursing staff and as the Best Doctor in America by his peers and has received numerous awards for his clinical and academic work.

 Dr. Kumar has served as a technical expert to ICMR, DBT, WHO and UNICEF. He has been Chairman and Member of various committees of NIN. His current areas of interest include quality improvement, neonatal hypothermia and prevention of healthcare associated infections.
